Department of Sociology of Government college of Arts and Science, organized a one-day online National Workshop on “Micro and Macro issues of Research Design in social Sciences Research”, on 7th January 2022. The Workshop was sponsored by the ICSSR.

. The Workshop began at 10.00 am, Dr. Pankaja waghmare, Head of the Department of Sanskrit, Government college of Arts and Science, Aurangabad compeered the workshop.

Dr. Pankaja waghmare welcomed the Principal of the College and Convener of the workshop, Dr. R.H. Satpute, Head of the Department of Sociology and Organizing Secretary of the Workshop, Dr. Surendra Thakur, Keynote speaker Dr. Shruti Tambe, Resources Person for the I Technical Session, Dr, Mansi Bawadekar, Resources Person for the I I Technical Session, and other dignitaries.

Dr. Surendra Thakur delivered the Introductory Speech wherein he gave the outline and need of the program. He stated that the concerned topic was selected with a view to encourage and help research students and faculty members in pursuing research. He thanked the Principal of the College and Convener of the workshop, Dr. R.H. Satpute for his encouragement and support. He also expressed his gratitude to the keynote speaker and resource persons for gracing the occasion.

The Principal of the College and Convener of the workshop, Dr. R.H. Satpute delivered the presidential address. With due respect to the Minister of higher education, Principal Secretary, Director, Joint Director of higher education, Vice Chancellor of Dr. Babasaheb Ambèdkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad. And other dignitaries he explained elaborately the importance of research design, methods of research, tools etc. He concluded his address by extending best wishes for the workshop.

Dr. Pankaja waghmare, Head of the Department of Sanskrit, Government college of Arts and Science, Aurangabad, introduced the Keynote Speaker. Dr. Shruti Tambe, Head of the department of Sociology, Centre for advanced studies, Savitribai Phule University, Pune. At the onset Dr. Tambe expressed her pleasure to be a part of the workshop as she is an alumna of Government college of Arts and Science. She put on record her gratitude to her teachers. She began her discourse with a question, How do we look at the research process? She went on to explain that the researcher should fit in the shoes of the respondent; he should sympathize with the respondent. As a sociologist one should have a global exposure and should be aware of the global scenario. One should not restrict oneself to his own research but mix with the society and give due credit to social reformers for their contribution. She added that epistemology and methodology are two important aspects of research.

Technical Session I: Dr. Pankaja waghmare introduced the resource person for the I Technical Session, Dr. Manasi Bawadekar, vice President of 'Salaam Bombay' foundation, Research and monetary evaluation, technical consultant of UNICEF.

She spoke on Research Design from Social Science perspective. She gave a beautiful definition of Research, she said that Research is a mysterious and fascinating domain and one unfolds various mysteries as one proceeds in Research. She threw light on types of research, methodology, objectives of research, process and research design. The choice of research design is the most crucial thing.

Technical Session II: Dr. Vatika Sibal was the resource person for the II Technical Session, She is an Associate Professor of Sociology at St. Andrews College, Mumbai. The topic of her discourse was "Ethics in Social Research" her talk began with a question, "How do we treat people on whom we conduct research?" She went on to explain the ethics involved in research, ethics are the set of rules that govern our expectations and other people's behavior. Research should be unbiased, legitimate, and unambiguous. General principles in research are honesty, integrity, objectivity, informed consent and respect for the respondent. The advantages of research ethics are that it promotes the aim of research, social and moral values. However there are certain limitations like psychological, social, legal and moral risks.

Question and answer Session: The technical session was followed by question and answer session. The experts answered the queries of the participants to their satisfaction.

A report on the workshop was read by Dr. Khan Shaista Talat from the department of English.

Feedback Session: Two Participants namely Mr. Hadley from Mumbai and Kirti Mane gave positive feedback of the webinar. There were a total of 517 registrations and 112 participants were present for the workshop.


This is with reference to your letter dated 28th July, 2021.
