F. This MOU shall require the ratification of the competent academic/executive body of both the institutions.

4. The Parties hereto clarify that since this understanding relates only to academic activities, none is liable to pay any amount to the other. As expenses involved shall be individually borne by the parties unless agree to otherwise.


